- 1. Convene R9ICH officials regularly in San Francisco (Bimonthly) - Cabrera**

- 2. Increase access to federal mainstream benefits for homeless people**
 - a. Complete follow up to stakeholder surveys (Dec) – **Cabrera**
 - b. HUD and SSA Forum in Los Angeles (Jan 8) - **Vasquez/ Robidart**
 - c. HUD and SSA Forum in San Diego (Feb) – **Vasquez/ Robidart**
 - d. Convene California Keys with federal partners (Quarterly) - **Cabrera**

- 3. Increase access to federal benefits for emancipated foster and homeless youth**
 - a. Identify and implement solutions that remove barriers for emancipated foster and homeless youth needing identification to access housing and services resources.
 - b. Consult w/ HUD and HHS to develop joint materials and training opportunities for those working with emancipated foster and homeless youth.
 - c. Partner with the City of San Francisco to deliver a Project Homeless Connect targeting homeless families and youth.
 - d. Develop mailing materials and an online resource on key agency contacts for emancipated foster and homeless youth.
